



Why Are We Here?

- •Many years with health issues, low lifespan and fertility-problems
- •Genetic COI 2023, 33 Bernese (whole-genome sequencing WGS): 39.5%
- •Large identical DNA segments in all Bernese tested
- Low genetic variation
- •Genetic COI Norway 2025, 32 Bernese (Embark 230,000 genetic markers): 31%



Measures Taken So Far

Relaxed HD/AD/show requirements

Exterior evaluations

Encourage the use of foreign sires

Information, education and webinars

Lowered inbreeding targets for 6 generations (but the inbreeding done many years ago is a bigger problem)

We have always had restrictions for usage of stud dogs (to avoid matador breeding/genetic bottle-necks)

HS-testing

Why is this NOT enough?

- Selection by traits and tests is ineffective with so little genetic variation
- There is breed-wide disease predisposition
- Everyone has a mother/father/brother/sister/cousin /uncle who died young in cancer
- Further **genetic loss** with every generation

NKK: Now in charge of the breeding programs of pure breeds: Launch of crossbreeding programs



Ethics and Law



NKK ethical guidelines: breed healthy, functional dogs



Inspired by 2023 Supreme Court ruling

Goals of <u>Controlled</u> Crossbreeding

Club: Revitalize the breed, but not change the essence of Bernese Mountain Dog

- Increase genetic diversity
- Preserve temperament and function
- Reduce health issues, increase life-span
- Mitigate inbreeding depression (fertility etc.)

Carol Beuchat, PhD:

"Crossbreeding does not threaten breed preservation. In fact, crossbreeding is one of the most powerful tools available to **protect a breed's genetic health** and long-term viability."



Choosing Breeds

Do not make it too difficult (NKK)

Temperament/function similar to the Bernese

Avoid breeds with similar problems, like cancer predisposition (rules out f. ex retrievers, rottweiler because of histiocytosis, etc.)

ANO register starts Sept 1, 2025

- All crossbred puppies registered in ANO
- Same rights as NO dogs (except CACIB)
- Eligible for shows and breeding

Breeding Model

- Cross with ca. 3 breeds (keep it open for individual assessment)
- Backcross 3 times in order to be registered into FCI register (NO)
- Parallel breeding in ANO and NO

Collaboration is the Key

International Cooperation

- Need for cross-border collaboration
- Collaboration in Nordic countries

Cooperation of breeders

- You can crossbreed (Norway needs ca. 5 crossings per year for sustainability)
- You can participate by buying/administering F1/F2 puppies
- You can lend your dog or lease your bitch to use in crossbreeding
- You can use ANO dogs in breeding
- You can promote and support the crossbreeding
